

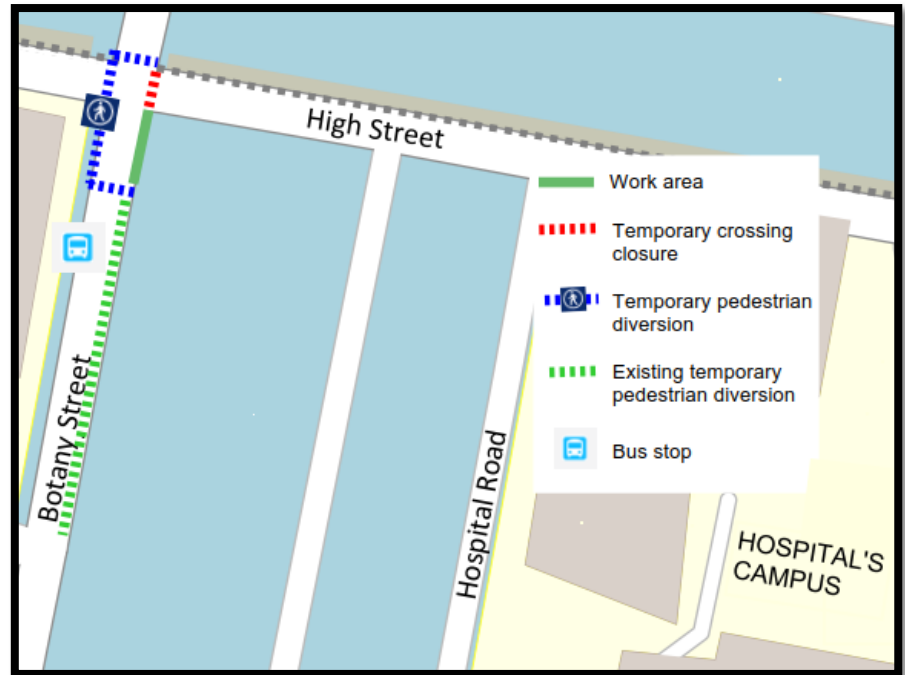
Changes to Botany Street pedestrian access – Saturday 16 March 2019

A temporary pedestrian detour will be in place from 8am to 5pm Saturday 16 March 2019 on Botany Street near High Street.

Traffic controllers will direct pedestrians to safely cross Botany Street at a temporary crossing. Ramps and signage will be in place to support pedestrian movements.

This pedestrian detour will allow the installation of a temporary covered walkway.

The temporary covered walkway will allow construction activity to be safely undertaken within the site boundary and enable safe pedestrian movements along Botany Street. This change will be in place for approximately 8 months.



Work to install the covered walkway will occur outside the construction hoarding on the pedestrian footpath.

This work will occur during standard site hours from 8am to 5pm Saturday 16 March 2019.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

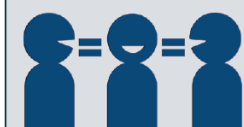
What can I expect to see?

To safely undertake work a temporary exclusion zone will be established on the Botany Street footpath. Work will be carried out inside the exclusion zone. A truck will be used to unload material. Personnel and hand equipment will be used to establish the temporary structure.
