

Temporary changes to High Street pedestrian access

A temporary pedestrian detour will be in place along High Street, between Hospital Road and Botany Street, from Wednesday 19 June 2019 for approximately two weeks.

What can I expect to see?

Pedestrians will be diverted to the northern footpath of High Street via the existing pedestrian crossings at the traffic lights. Traffic controllers will be in place to support pedestrian movements.

This pedestrian detour is required to enable important construction activity including the delivery of new sewer and stormwater infrastructure by the Randwick Campus Redevelopment.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.
