# **Community Notice – February 2020**

Construction activities for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment will continue in 2020. This community notice provides a summary of activities planned for February 2020.

All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority. The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls, and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration.

Where possible activities are scheduled during standard site hours. Standard site hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 5pm Saturdays.

At times specific construction activities must be scheduled during weekends or evenings for traffic and safety reasons either due to the location or impact of the works. Respite periods for noisy works apply. Information about activities that may affect local stakeholders is provided in advance to inform the community about upcoming work.

We are working closely with Transport for NSW, CBD and South East Light Rail, UNSW Sydney and Randwick City Council to coordinate construction in the Randwick Precinct and minimise any impacts on the community.

Activities may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

# Activities continuing in February 2020

- Earthworks and general construction activities including tower crane operation within the construction site boundary
- Hoarding modifications and pedestrian diversions as required to facilitate work within the road or footpath
- High Street and Botany Street footpath closures

### New and upcoming activities

Tower cranes to support construction activity in Hospital Road - Tower Cranes will be used to lift material into the fenced construction zones along Hospital Road. No lifting will occur over Magill Street or nearby properties.

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#### Upcoming construction activities during extended hours

Specific construction activities are required to be scheduled during weekends or evenings for traffic and safety reasons. The following activities are scheduled to occur during extended hours in February.

- Trenching and electrical work will occur on Hospital Road and Delivery Drive, during extended hours from 6am to 6pm on Saturday 1 February and Sunday 2 February to maintain hospital services. Noisier activities including rockbreaking and jackhammering will mostly occur within the hospital site in Delivery Drive. Noisier work will be limited to 7am to 5pm and respite periods apply.
- Electrical work and removal of redundant power poles will occur on Magill Street and Botany Street on Sunday 2 February between 6am and 6pm. As part of this work safety exclusion zones will be in place occupying several parking spaces along the northern and southern kerbs of Magill Street. Traffic control will be in place to manage safe and coordinated vehicle and pedestrian movements. Access and parking for residents will be maintained. Work will be carried out using elevated work platforms, trucks and construction equipment.

The above works have been scheduled in coordination with a local planned power outage by Ausgrid on Sunday 2 February. Community notification for the power outage has been provided directly by Ausgrid and Fredon (the Accredited Service Provider undertaking the work) to properties affected by the planned power outage.
