Community Notice – January 2020

Construction activities for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment will continue in 2020. This community notice provides a summary of upcoming activities planned for January 2020.

All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls, and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration.

We are working closely with Transport for NSW, CBD and South East Light Rail, UNSW Sydney and Randwick City Council to coordinate construction in the Randwick Precinct and minimise any impacts on the community.

Activities may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

Activities continuing in January 2020

- Earthworks and general construction activities within the construction site boundary
- Hoarding modifications and pedestrian diversions
- Tower cranes in operation
- Out of hours deliveries
- · Work activities on or near the site boundary
- Infrastructure works on Hospital Road including trenching and construction of new electricity pits (access will be maintained under the support of traffic control) and associated changes to access.

Christmas period site closure

The site will close on Friday 20 December 2019 and reopen Thursday 2 January 2020.

During the site closure there will be:

- No construction activities
- Additional dust control measures
- 24/7 security patrols to maintain site security and safety.

New and upcoming activities

- Concrete pouring and truck movements Concrete pouring will occur as the Acute Services Building structure works progress. Concrete pouring will occur within the site boundary.
- Temporary footbath diversions High Street and Botany Street Temporary footpath diversions and hoarding
 modifications are required along High Street and Botany Street to safely undertake trenching work and services
 upgrades. Traffic control and signage will be in place to support pedestrian movements. Power supply to private
 property will not be affected during this work.

Construction site hours

Standard site hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 5pm Saturdays. Truck movements are being minimised during peak traffic times to reduce impacts on local roads and the community.
