

# Hospital Road lowering Stage 2 construction update – July 2020 to late 2020

Over \$1.5 billion is being invested in health, education and research at Randwick to build a world-class precinct that will deliver cutting-edge, compassionate and holistic healthcare and wellness programs to the local community and other residents of NSW.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment will bring Hospital Road into the centre of the expanded hospitals campus, to enable development of the Integrated Acute Services Building (IASB) and future-proof the Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick Stage 1 redevelopment, Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre and development of UNSW Sydney's Health Translation Hub. With this comes the opportunity to reimagine this part of the campus within the context of the

Precinct's vision to create healthy, green and connected spaces.


To ensure operational continuity of the Randwick Hospitals Campus, the works on Hospital Road will be delivered in multiple stages and are planned in close consultation with key stakeholders to manage any potential impacts on patients, staff and residents.

#### **Hospital Road access changes**

- No through-access on Hospital Road for any vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles
- Access to Hospital Campus car park and Francis Martin Drive maintained from Hospital Road (south) via Barker Street
- Delivery drive access for service and logistics vehicles maintained from Hospital Road (north) via Hight St

### Stage 2 Hospital Road construction activity – July 2020 to late 2020

 Establishment of construction site compounds and safety exclusion zones to ensure the safety of construction workers, road users and pedestrians



Stage 2 Hospital Road works – Access to Hospital Campus

- Temporary closure of Hospital Road B2 car park entry to support construction activity including trenching, excavation, piling activity and restorative works
- Temporary single lane closures along Hospital Road and Delivery Drive under the support of traffic control
- Services investigations along Hospital Road, between High and Barker Streets, to identify underground service locations
- Temporary weekend closures of Delivery Drive
- Footpath pavement works, construction of new road surface and restorative works
- Piling and bulk excavation along Hospital Road and Delivery Drive
- Trenching work, services installation and general construction activity

## RANDWICK **CAMPUS REDEVELOPMENT**

#### Hospital Road Stage 2 Piling and Bulk **Excavation**

#### **Piling**

Piling is required to facilitate excavation and support the lowering of Hospital Road. Piles are constructed by drilling into the ground and filling the hole with a steel cage and concrete.

An alternative piling method will be used which generates less noise and vibration than other types of piling.

Prior to delivery of the piling rig, a stable base made of compacted material will be established on site. A vibratory roller will be used to compact and stabilise the base for the piling rig. Vibration levels are continuously monitored and kept within strict environmental controls during the works.

Piling activity will be carried out along Hospital Road and Delivery Drive, adjacent to the Ainsworth building. All piling activity will be undertaken inside the construction compound and within Delivery Drive during weekend closures.

Piling activities will take approximately two months to complete. Additional piling will occur during Stage 3.

#### **Bulk Excavation**

Bulk excavation involves the removal of sand and rock from Hospital Road.

Work on site will be carried out by excavators, jack hammers, rock saws and hammers, and truck and trailers. This phase of work will involve some rockbreaking activities which may be disruptive at times.

Mitigation measures will be in place to manage noise, dust and vibration and respite periods will apply to rock-breaking activities.

All bulk excavation will be undertaken inside the Hospital Road site compound.

Stage 2 bulk excavation will take approximately two months to complete. Additional excavation will occur during stage 3.

#### Construction hours and managing noise and vibration

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration.

Respite periods apply to noisy works that will be carried out including rock cutting and use of jackhammers.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment continues to implement measures in accordance with the latest NSW Health advice to minimise risk of exposure and reduce the spread of COVID-19, including approved extended work hours of:


- Monday Friday 6:00 am 10:00pm
- Saturday 7:00am 5:00pm

To minimise disruption to Hospital Campus access and operations, some construction activity will be scheduled during the following times:

- Saturday 5:00pm 10:00pm
- Sunday 8:00am 10:00pm

Advanced notification will be provided to affected stakeholders with planned high noise activities undertaken prior to 5:00pm.

Works may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
