

RANDWICK CAMPUS REDEVELOPMENT

Out of hours demobilisation of plant and equipment from Hospital Road via High Street on Monday 17 August 2020

Stage 2 Hospital Road lowering is underway with piling works progressing along Delivery Drive and Hospital Road. Piling will create retention support for bulk excavation work.

Piling plant and equipment will be demobilised and removed from the Hospital Road construction compound out of normal construction hours.

Demobilisation will occur on Monday 17 August between 2:00am and 6:00am and will take approximately 1 hour to complete.

Plant and equipment removal will be made to the north of Hospital Road via High Street. Equipment will be loaded from High Street onto an oversized truck. During this time single traffic lane closures will be in place under the support of traffic control.

It is a requirement of Roads and Maritime Services that truck movements of this size occur out of hours.

Lighting towers will be used to enable safe loading of piling equipment. Lighting will be positioned to minimise impact on surrounding buildings.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances of inclement weather.
