



Upcoming works along Hospital Road north and Magill Street

From **Friday 13 November to Friday 20 November 2020** tower cranes will be used to lift precast material over Hospital Road and into the construction site.

A safety exclusion zone will be established in the northbound lane of Hospital Road, adjacent to the Ainsworth building.

For traffic and safety reasons, there will be intermittent, temporary single lane closures throughout the works program, outside of peak times, with lane closures in place for 30 minutes up to four times each day.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.

From **16 November 2020**, a redundant water supply will be disconnected outside the construction hoarding in the northern verge of Magill Street, close to the Hospital Road intersection.

Disconnection work requires manual digging, backfilling and road restoration, during standard construction hours and will take one day to complete.

Small excavators and personnel will be used to carry out this work. All road services will be restored following completion.

Safety exclusion zones will be established in the no-stopping zone along the northern kerb of Magill Street. Water supply to private properties will not be affected during this work.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances of inclement weather. Thank you for your patience during this important work.
