

### Updated construction activity and the temporary closure of Delivery Drive over extended weekend hours

Please note that closure of Delivery Drive has been postponed for this weekend, Friday 7 August to Sunday 9 August. Regular construction works will occur on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> August as per normal working hours.

Work to deliver the Prince of Wales Hospital Integrated Acute Services Building is underway. As part of this work, temporary closures of Delivery Drive to undertake piling and bulk excavation over extended weekend hours are required.

During this time, piling and bulk excavation will be carried out along Hospital Road and Delivery Drive. Respite periods apply to noisy activities including rock cutting and use of jackhammers.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration.

To enable development of the Integrated Acute Services Building and future-proof the Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick Stage 1 redevelopment, Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre and development of UNSW Sydney's Health Translation Hub, works on Hospital Road are required throughout 2020.

Out-of-hours and weekend work are required to minimize impact to Hospital operations. Up to 30 weekends of work will be scheduled across the duration of 2020.
