NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

What is happening?

The future UNSW Health Translation Hub (HTH) will form a key part of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment and strengthen the broader Randwick Health & Innovation Precinct through the integration of additional health education, training and research capacity with acute healthcare services.

The HTH site is now occupied by project builders Hansen Yuncken, with site establishment activities underway in preparation for construction works.

Initial activities will see the realignment of site hoarding along the Botany Street perimeter, requiring a temporary closure of the footpath between High Street and site access Gate A for approximately three days from Monday 22 May. All pedestrians will be redirected to the western footpath under traffic control for the duration of these works. On completion of works, pedestrian access will be reinstated.

Realignment of the hoarding will result in temporary removal of the Botany Street bicycle lane between High Street and the new signalised intersection at Library Walk to support safe pedestrian travel on the narrowed pathway for the duration of construction.

Upcoming works on site will include the delivery and establishment of site sheds and storage compounds. Associated truck movements along Botany Street will be managed through a comprehensive Traffic Management Plan and any planned out of hours works will be communicated accordingly.
