6 April 2019 – 17 April 2019

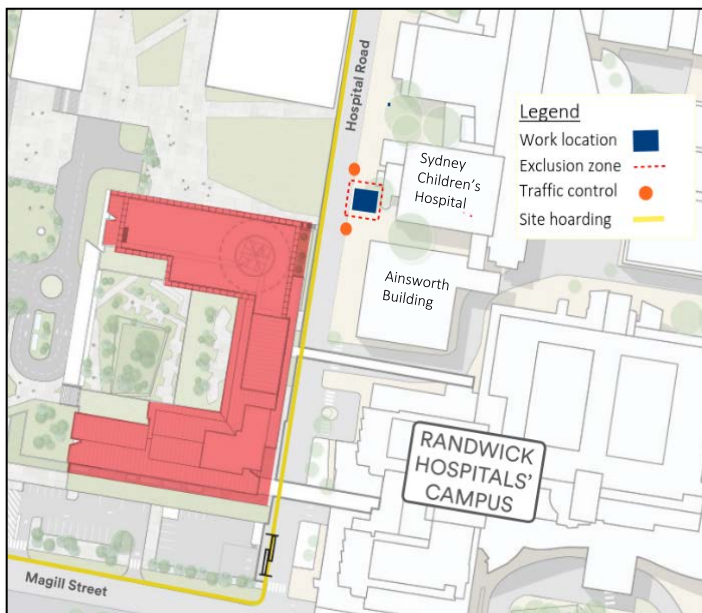
Work to establish the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project site continues.

A temporary electricity kiosk will be installed in the verge along Hospital Road. The kiosk will supply power for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment construction site.

Work activities

- Establish safety exclusion zone and temporary pedestrian diversion around the work zone
- Works to relocate nearby building vent
- Hand and machine excavation within the existing Hospital Road verge
- Unloading of the temporary electricity kiosk from a truck
- Installation of the temporary electricity kiosk
- Backfilling of excavations and tidying of work area.



How will access be managed?

Hospital and emergency access will be maintained throughout the work and pedestrians will be diverted with the support of traffic controllers.

Work hours

All work is scheduled to occur during approved site hours:

- Monday – Friday 6:00am – 6:00pm, and
- Saturday 8:00am – 5:00pm.

Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

The NSW Government is investing \$720 million to strengthen the Randwick health and education precinct as a world-leading centre for health and wellbeing, research, education and teaching.

A new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building will be built in Stage 1 including an adult emergency department, extra beds, intensive care unit, and new operating theatres for the campus. The Acute Services Building will open in 2022.
