## Hospital Road electricity upgrades extended working hours. March to early April 2020

Work to upgrade the Ausgrid High Voltage network is underway on the Randwick Hospital Campus within site compounds in Hospital Road and Delivery Drive.

During March and early April, construction activity will be carried out on the underground power network upgrade Monday to Friday 7am to 10pm and Saturday and Sunday 7am to 7pm.

Where possible, equipment deliveries and noisier works will be scheduled during standard work hours with lower impact activities continuing later in the shift.

These extended work hours will be in place for work on the Ausgrid High Voltage power network upgrade from March 2020 until early April 2020.

Work activities to occur out of hours include:

- Excavation
- Underground boring
- Pit construction and concreting.

Lighting towers will be used to provide safe working conditions and will be positioned to minimise light spill on surrounding buildings.

## Services investigations on High Street near previous intersection with Eurimbla Avenue, one evening shift between Wednesday 4 March and Friday 6 March

Services investigations will be carried out on High Street, between Botany Street and Hospital Road, to inspect inground services. Work will occur outside the construction hoarding on the road pavement.

For traffic and safety reasons this work will occur out of hours between 9pm and 5am. One night of work is required.

To safely undertake work pedestrians and traffic diversions will be in place under the support of traffic control and road signage.

High Street will be closed to westbound traffic between Hospital Road and Botany Street. Access to private property will be maintained.

Services investigations requires saw cutting of the road service, vacuum excavation, backfilling and road restoration. A vacuum truck and personnel will be used to carry out this work.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.
