

## From 23 March 2020, through-access on Hospital Road is closing

To deliver the Integrated Acute Services Building (ASB) and prepare for future stages of the project, changes to Hospital Road are required.

From 23 March 2020, vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists will no longer be able to travel the full length of Hospital Road between High Street and Barker Street.

A section of Hospital Road will be lowered and transition to a service road. This service road will continue to support campus logistics and emergency access as well as access to the campus carpark.



### How will this change be implemented?

To ensure operational continuity of the Randwick Hospitals Campus, the works on Hospital Road are being delivered in multiple stages. This staged methodology has been carefully planned in consultation with stakeholders to ensure continuity of logistics, emergency and public access to the campus, loading docks and carpark and to minimise the impact on neighbouring residents.

### What can I expect to see on Hospital Road?

- Hospital Road closed to through-traffic
- Establishment of a construction site and safety exclusion zones to ensure the safety of construction workers, road users and pedestrians
- Installation of road and pedestrian signage to support safe and coordinated travel to and from the Randwick Hospitals Campus
- A new vehicle turnaround bay on the northern section of Hospital Road to maintain access back to High Street
- To improve local access, a new boom gate will soon be installed at the intersection of Hospital Road and Magill Street allowing access to the campus carpark between 7am and 10pm, 7 days per week
- Access to Francis Martin Drive and levels B2 and B3 of the campus carpark will be maintained from Barker Street.

### What construction activities will be undertaken?

Work will include modification of underground utilities and vegetation removal.

Intermittent service investigations and potholing will occur outside the Hospital Road construction site and on Delivery Drive, under the support of traffic control.

Construction vehicle access to the Hospital Road works will be via Barker Street.

Construction vehicle movements will be minimised during peak traffic hours to mitigate impacts on the local road network.

### Construction hours, and managing noise and vibration

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration. Respite periods apply to noisy works.

Construction activity is scheduled to occur during approved site hours Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, and Saturday 8am to 5pm. Some activities may be required to occur outside standard hours for traffic and safety reasons and will be notified in advance.

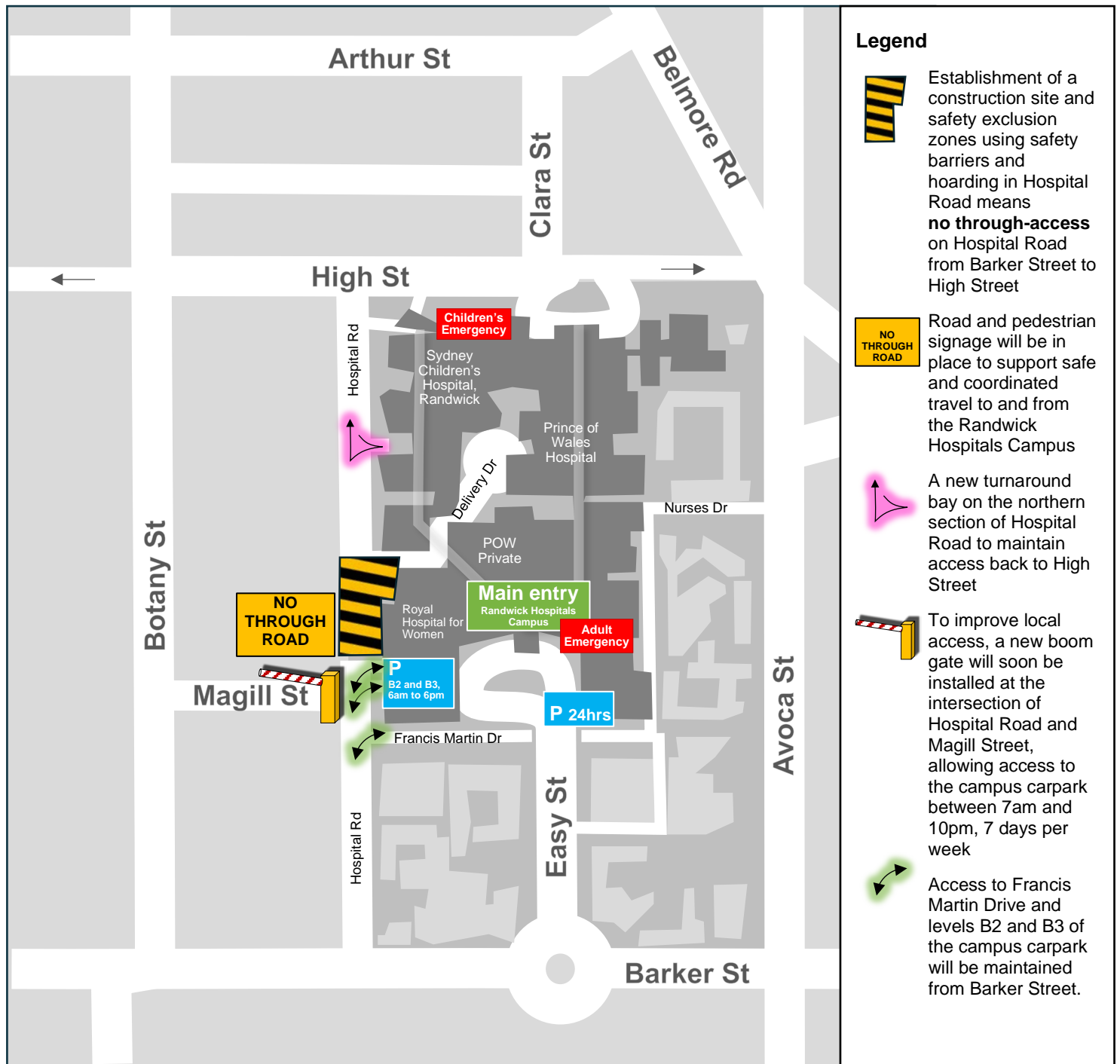
