

New children's health and research facilities at Randwick

The NSW and Federal Governments have announced \$608 million to deliver brand new, state-of-the-art paediatric health and medical research facilities as part of the first stage of redeveloping Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick. The redevelopment will include Australia's first Comprehensive Children's Cancer Centre and brings world-leading clinical care, research and teaching together to deliver improved models of care for sick and injured children. This is the next exciting phase of the broader Randwick Campus Redevelopment.

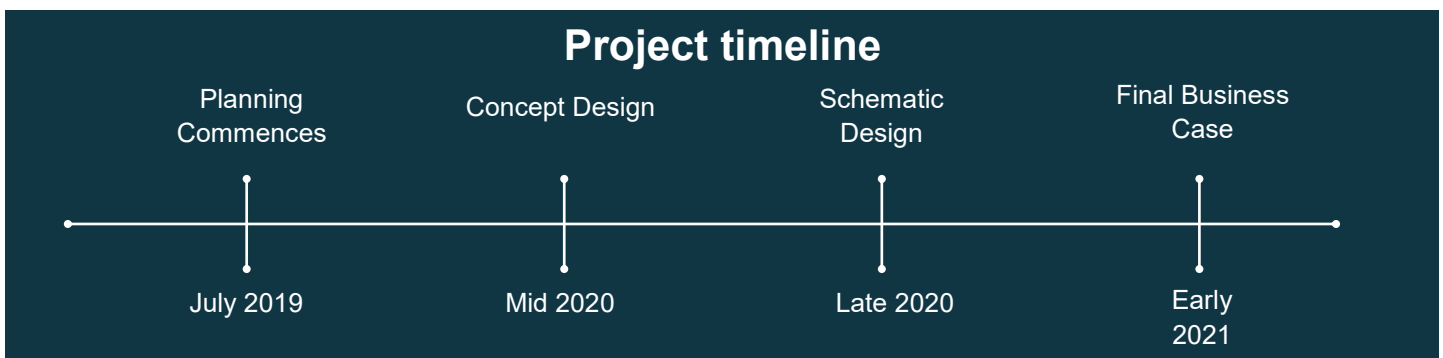

What services will be located in the new building?

- A new children's Emergency Department, accessible from Botany Street
- Short Stay Unit / Medical Assessment Unit
- Emergency Department patient drop off zone from Botany Street
- Main entry from Botany Street as well as front of house services
- Australia's first Comprehensive Children's Cancer Centre bringing together the Children's Cancer Institute and the Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick's Kids Cancer Centre to deliver integrated, specialist cancer treatment and research
- Additional clinical services to be determined through the planning process.

About the redevelopment

Bounded by Hospital Road, High Street and Botany Street, the redevelopment will connect with UNSW's Health Translation Hub to bring the Randwick Hospitals Campus and UNSW Kensington Campus closer together, forming an integrated Randwick Health and Education Precinct.

The new Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick building will be more than 50 per cent larger than the existing hospital building and will allow researchers and clinicians to work side by side to deliver world-leading clinical care.

The Comprehensive Children's Cancer Centre will transform children's cancer care, delivering better health outcomes through the rapid translation of clinical research into effective treatments for patients

Where are we now?

The NSW Government has committed funding to commence pre-planning for the redevelopment as part of the June 2019 State Budget.

The Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick Clinical Services Plan – 2031 is the first critical stage in early planning for the new hospital building. The Plan uses current health data to forecast the changing population and the future clinical and health needs of children and families. As the Plan is developed, health planners will assess how these healthcare needs will be serviced, while also considering relationships to nearby health services, facilities and networks.

The Final Business Case for the redevelopment will be completed in 2020 along with the initial design of the new building.



Delivering the project

This significant investment has been made possible through funding commitments from the NSW Government (\$428 million), Federal Government (\$100 million), UNSW Sydney (\$30 million), Sydney Children's Hospitals Foundation (\$25 million) and the Children's Cancer Institute (\$25 million).

The redevelopment is being delivered by Health Infrastructure in partnership with Sydney Children's Hospitals Network, Children's Cancer Institute and UNSW Sydney. Planning, designing and building a hospital takes time and Health Infrastructure will continue to work closely with Precinct partners, government, consumers and the community to deliver the best possible infrastructure to meet healthcare needs now and into the future.
