

RANDWICK CAMPUS REDEVELOPMENT

Out of hours electrical works on Hospital Road and Botany Street

Works to upgrade the Ausgrid High Voltage network supply to the Randwick Campus Redevelopment site is underway along Hospital Road and Botany Street.

Out of hours construction is required to support this essential infrastructure, with activities planned between 6:00pm and 5:00am from Sunday 20 June to Saturday 26 June 2021.

Up to 6 nights of work will be carried out in various locations on Hospital Road and Botany Street.

Activities will include cable pulling and installation, with traffic control in place.

Lighting towers will be in operation to support worker safety and will be positioned to minimise the impact on surrounding buildings.

On **Monday 21 June, between 6:00pm – 9:00pm**, a vacuum truck will be operating on Hospital Road to remove water from the pit in preparation for the electrical works. There will be some noise whilst the vacuum truck completes this work.

Power supply to private properties will be maintained during this work. This activity is being carried out under an Ausgrid authority approval.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances of inclement weather.
