

RANDWICK CAMPUS REDEVELOPMENT

Out of hours equipment delivery via Botany Street - Monday 22 - Saturday 27 March

Two tower cranes are operating at the Randwick Campus Redevelopment to support delivery of the Integrated Acute Services Building (IASB).

The Prince of Wales Hospital Integrated Acute Services Building has reached its full height and the southern tower crane will be partially lowered. Both tower cranes will continue operation to support façade installation and structure completion.

To undertake crane lowering, delivery of a mobile crane will occur out of hours on **Monday 22 March between 2:00am and 5:00am.**

The mobile crane will be used within the site boundary and will operate for approximately 6 days during daytime construction hours between **Monday 22 March and Saturday 27 March**.

Once this work is complete, the mobile crane will be removed from site during out of hours.

It is a requirement of Transport for NSW that equipment movements of this size occur out of hours. Traffic control will be in place to support vehicle movements.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances of inclement weather.
