Community Notice – June 2020

This community notice details construction activities scheduled to occur in June 2020 for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment.

All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

We endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum, and where possible, activities are scheduled during approved site hours:

- Monday to Friday 6am 10pm
- Saturday 7am 5pm

Specific works may be conducted outside of these construction hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic and hospital access, and will be notified accordingly.



Works are dependent on weather and site conditions and are subject to change.

We thank you for your patience while we expand our world-class health, research and education facilities.

Ongoing activities

- General construction activities within and near the site boundary
- Tower crane operation within site boundary and supporting construction activity in Hospital Road
- Hoarding modifications and pedestrian diversions as required to facilitate work within the road or footpath
- Landscaping and footpath reinstatement on Botany Street, between Magill and High Streets
- Deliveries to and from site (including oversized and out of hours deliveries)
- · No through access on Hospital Road for any vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles
- Construction on Hospital Road and Delivery Drive
- Out of hours concrete pouring and finishing

New construction activities

Activity	Summary
New secure site access on High Street	A new secure entry point has been created along High Street, to provide safe access for all site workers, project team members and visitors to the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project site.
Establishment of additional smaller site compound on Hospital Road	A site compound will be established along Hospital Road, to the north of Delivery Drive, to enable sewer and storm water services work to be carried out. This work will require saw-cutting, trenching in the road surface and excavation work. During these activities there will be temporary single lane closures. Traffic access to Delivery Drive will be maintained, with traffic control in place and a safety exclusion zone established around the work area.

Modifications to construction in response to COVID-19

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment continues implement precautionary workplace measures in accordance with the latest NSW Health advice to minimise the risk of exposure and reduce the spread of COVID-19.

Controls in place include physical distancing, increased cleaning regimes, hygiene education and extended work hours.

Extended hours are a temporary measure to ensure worker safety and maintain progress on the construction of essential health facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The following construction hours will be implemented at the RCR project site:

- Monday to Friday 6am 10pm
- Saturday 7am 5pm.

Additional mitigation measures will be in place to manage construction during extended work hours including scheduling of high noise generating works in standard work hours, careful positioning of lighting and managing construction delivery times to minimise disruption to neighbouring residents and businesses.

June long weekend site closure

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment construction site will be closed on Monday 8 June and Tuesday 9 June. During this time there will be no work undertaken on site. Additional 24/7 security patrols will be in place to maintain construction site security and safety.
