Hospital Campus noise monitoring - Managing construction noise at the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project site.

Today we are conducting investigations within the Hospital Campus to record noise levels generated by construction activity occurring on Hospital Road.

This information is used to inform construction planning and impacts management at the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project site.

It is a requirement of our planning approval that we monitor construction impacts and implement appropriate controls to minimise disruption to the Hospital Campus.

Monitoring will ensure construction noise levels remain within tolerances prescribed under our planning approval.

Additional controls to manage noise include:

- Noise monitoring and back to base alarm system
- Selection of equipment and machinery that mitigates noise
- Scheduling of noisy work activities during daytime hours
- Respite periods for high noise generating activities
- Compliance with standards for noise management.

Contractors will access this area for approximately 15minutes. Handheld devices will be used to monitor noise levels.

Contractors are inducted to understand their obligations when working in a live hospital environment and will prioritise the privacy and safety of staff, patients and visitors.
