

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Construction activity and the temporary closure of Delivery Drive over extended weekend hours

Work to deliver the Prince of Wales Hospital Integrated Acute Services Building is underway. As part of this work, temporary closures of Delivery Drive to undertake piling and bulk excavation over extended weekend hours are required.

Weekend closures of Delivery Drive	Piling and Bulk Excavation

Friday 7 August to Sunday 9 August	Planned closure*
Friday 14 August to Sunday 16 August	Planned closure*
Friday 21 August to Sunday 23 August	Road open, no closure in place
Friday 28 August to Sunday 30 August	Contingency closure*

***All closures will be between 5:00pm Friday and 10:00pm Sunday**

During this time, piling and bulk excavation will be carried out along Hospital Road and Delivery Drive. Respite periods apply to noisy activities including rock cutting and use of jackhammers.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration.

Out of hours deliveries of plant and equipment via Hospital Road

The delivery of plant and equipment will occur out of hours on **Thursday 30 July, between 3:00am and 6:00am** and take approximately 1 hour to complete.

The delivery will be made to the south of Hospital Road from Barker Street using an oversized truck. It is a requirement of Roads and Maritime Services that deliveries of this size occur out of hours. Traffic control will be in place to support vehicle movements.

Plant and equipment will be unloaded on Hospital Road at the site compound near the Hospital Car Park entry and be stored within the site boundary.

Lighting towers will be used to enable safe unloading of piling equipment. Lighting will be positioned to minimise impact on surrounding buildings.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances of inclement weather.

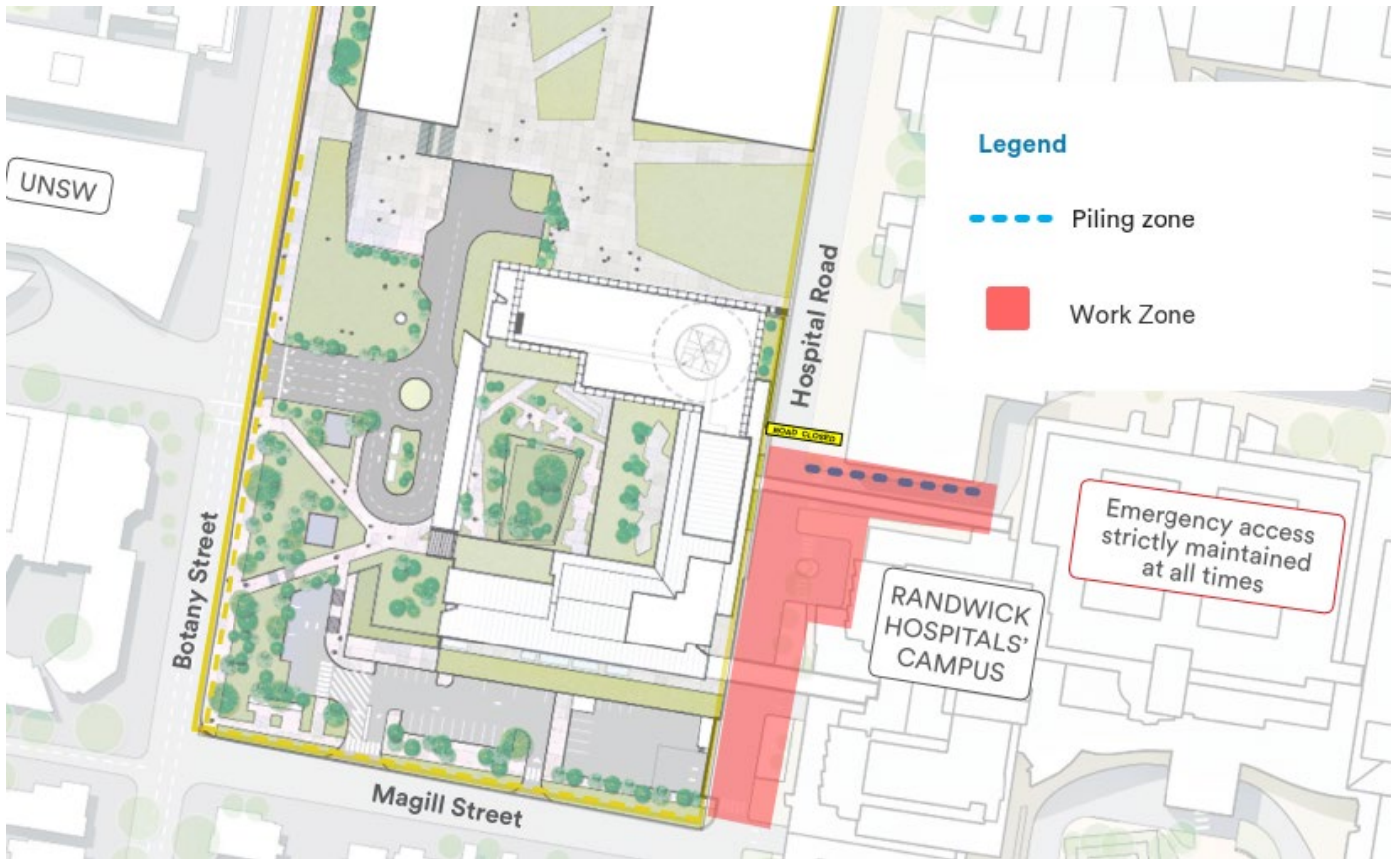

To enable development of the Integrated Acute Services Building and future-proof the Sydney Children’s Hospital, Randwick Stage 1 redevelopment, Children’s Comprehensive Cancer Centre and development of UNSW Sydney’s Health Translation Hub, works on Hospital Road are required throughout 2020.

Out-of-hours and weekend work are required to minimize impact to Hospital operations. Up to 30 weekends of work will be scheduled across the duration of 2020.

Advanced notification will be provided for any out-of-hours and weekend work.
