

### Community Notice – May 2020

**This community notice summarises construction activities scheduled to occur in May 2020 for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment.**

All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

We endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum. Where possible, activities are scheduled during standard site hours 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 5pm Saturdays.

Specific works may be conducted outside of standard construction hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic and hospital access.

Works are dependent on weather and site conditions and are subject to change. For further information on works outside of standard construction hours, please visit our website.

#### Ongoing activities

- Earthworks and general construction activities within and near the site boundary
- Tower crane operation within site boundary and supporting construction activity in Hospital Road
- Hoarding modifications and pedestrian diversions as required to facilitate work within the road or footpath
- High Street footpath closure and restoration including night work and traffic changes on High Street between Botany Street and Hospital Road
- Deliveries to and from site (including oversized and out of hours deliveries)
- Infrastructure works on Hospital Road and Delivery Drive including some extended working hours and night shifts for cable pulling and electrification works
- No through access on Hospital Road for any vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles
- Out of hours concrete finishing.

#### New construction activities

Activity	Summary
<b>Trenching across Botany Street with a temporary single lane closure</b>	Trenching work to connect a new water main for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment will be carried out along Botany Street, north of Magill Street. Trenching requires saw-cutting of the road surface, excavation and connection of water supply. Backfilling and restoration works will be carried out upon completion to reinstate the road surface. These works will be completed out of hours from 8:00pm – 6:00am with lane closures and traffic control in place to assist pedestrians and motorists.
<b>Foxtel cable and power pole removal – Corner of Magill and Botany Streets</b>	Telstra will carry out work to remove an overhead Foxtel cable at the intersection of Magill Street and Botany Street. Work is scheduled to occur in early May and will take approximately one day to complete. This work will be carried out during standard site hours. Telstra will provide advanced notification of any planned interruption to Foxtel supply including confirmed outage timing. Once cable removal work is complete the redundant power pole will be removed using elevated work platform. This work will take approximately one day to complete. Pedestrians and traffic will be diverted around a safety exclusion zone under the support of traffic control. Power supply to private property will not be impacted during this work.
<b>Temporary access via Gate 3 on Hospital Road</b>	Temporary access will be activated via Gate 3, located on Hospital Road near Magill Street, to support construction access to and from the southern section of site. Gate 3 will be used at times, during standard site hours between 6am and 6pm. During this time traffic controllers will be stationed along Hospital Road to support safe and coordinated vehicle movements during this time.
