

Botany Street signalised intersection weekend works –

RANDWICK

Saturday 12 to Sunday 13 November

Construction continues on the new signalised intersection on Botany Street to support safe pedestrian and vehicle access to both the Randwick Hospitals Campus and the UNSW Kensington Campus.

The majority of this work is being undertaken at night in line with Transport for NSW and Department of Planning and Environment authority approvals, and with ongoing consultation with impacted stakeholders

To support completion of this project, weekend works are scheduled from Saturday 12 to Sunday 13 November, between 8am and 10pm daily, weather permitting.

Works will include concrete cutting, hammering and excavation. While every effort will be made to minimise disruption, some noise can be expected.

Pedestrian and vehicular access to UNSW will be maintained at all times through traffic control.
