Notification of evening/weekend works for tower crane removal -Friday 12 to Sunday 14 July 2024

With construction of the new Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre well progressed, the first of two tower cranes will soon be removed from site.

Approved after-hours and weekend works to support the crane removal will commence 6pm on Friday 12 July, with overnight and weekend works continuing through to 10pm on Saturday 13 July (weather permitting). Any remaining works will be completed between 6am and 10pm on Sunday 14 July.

The works will involve setting up a mobile crane to support the dismantling of the tower crane, followed by loading the dismantled crane onto trucks and trailers for removal via the Botany Street site access.

These activities may result in minor noise impacts from vehicles entering and exiting the site, the use of tools, and the loading and unloading of equipment and crane infrastructure. To ensure safety during night activities, site lighting will also be utilised.

Thank you for your ongoing patience while we deliver this important project.
