


# **Community Notice**Randwick Campus Redevelopment



## **Construction Update**

Delivery of the Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre (SCH1/MCCCC) project and adjacent UNSW Health Translation Hub (HTH) continues, alongside internal fit-out works within the Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building (ASB) and refurbishment activities in previously vacated hospital spaces.

### Upcoming activities

## Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre

Alongside internal fit-out works and service installations across all levels within the building, external landscaping of terraces and public domain spaces continues on site. Installation of playground equipment, outdoor seating and landscaping within the southern forecourt is also well underway.

Ongoing works to complete the future High Street entrance forecourt will require intermittent pedestrian and vehicle diversions during May, including a single-day High Street lane closure for westbound vehicles. Access to the Children's Emergency Department will be maintained at all times during these works.

### Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building and broader campus

Internal fit-out works within Level 1 of the ASB will continue through to late 2025 to deliver the future Acute Services Operating Suite.

Refurbishment works within previously vacated Prince of Wales Hospital spaces also continue. Mitigation measures are in place to minimise construction impacts and support the continuity of hospital operations during the works.

#### **UNSW Health Translation Hub**

Works to complete internal fit-out across all levels continues alongside external landscaping activities.

To enable continued works on the building's public domain space, pedestrian diversions to the northern

footpath on High Street will be in place intermittently throughout May.


Landscaping works adjacent to the pedestrian link bridge support column on Botany Street will be undertaken in late May, temporarily closing the western footpath for a period of one week, with pedestrian diversions to the eastern footpath.

#### Managing construction activities

We are committed to minimising the impact of our works. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community and site workers as our top priority, and we endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum. Where possible, activities are scheduled during approved site hours of **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 5pm**. Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Out of hours work will be communicated directly to affected stakeholders, with all activity dates and times remaining subject to change. Inaudible concrete finishing and other works may extend beyond 6pm where necessary, in line with planning conditions. Delivery of construction materials and equipment may also be undertaken out of hours where required by law due to vehicle size. Please note that service upgrades unrelated to the project may also be undertaken by other agencies at any time without notification.
