



## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

## What is happening?

As part of ongoing works to complete the UNSW Eastern Extension component of the new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services building, fit-out contractor site sheds and storage compounds will soon be installed on Hospital Road, adjacent to Delivery Drive. Following installation, the facilities will be occupied by contractors AW Edwards for approximately 12 months to enable fit-out activities within the UNSW Eastern Extension.

## Site establishment activities are scheduled for Thursday 11 May from 7am to 6pm.

Activities will include a number of heavy vehicle movements along Hospital Road between 10am and 3pm to deliver site sheds and materials. Due to their size, the transportation vehicles will enter the site from Barker Street, reversing along Hospital Road to the site establishment zone to unload, and leaving the site in a forward direction via Hospital Road.

All reversing vehicles will be escorted by traffic control and sequenced in a staged approach, allowing only one transportation vehicle to enter and exit Hospital Road at any given time. Traffic controllers will be stationed at each Hospital Road intersection to support safe flow of vehicles travelling within the campus.

These works may result in minor noise impacts from reversing vehicles, along with the unloading of equipment and materials.

While there may be temporary delays to traffic flow as transportation vehicles reverse along Hospital Road, there will be minimal impact to loading dock and car park access. Pedestrian and emergency vehicle access to the hospital will be maintained at all times. Access to the Prince of Wales Hospital Emergency Department from Magill Street, via Botany Street, will not be impacted.
