

## Notification of evening/weekend works and temporary road closure for link bridge installation – Friday 14 to Monday 17 June 2024

Construction is underway on the **UNSW Health Translation Hub (HTH)**, part of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment. The HTH will strengthen UNSW's connection with the Randwick Health & Innovation Precinct through the integration of additional health education, training and research capacity with acute healthcare services.

A new pedestrian bridge over Botany Street, between UNSW's Wallace Wurth Building and the HTH, will further support the connection between the university and health campuses.

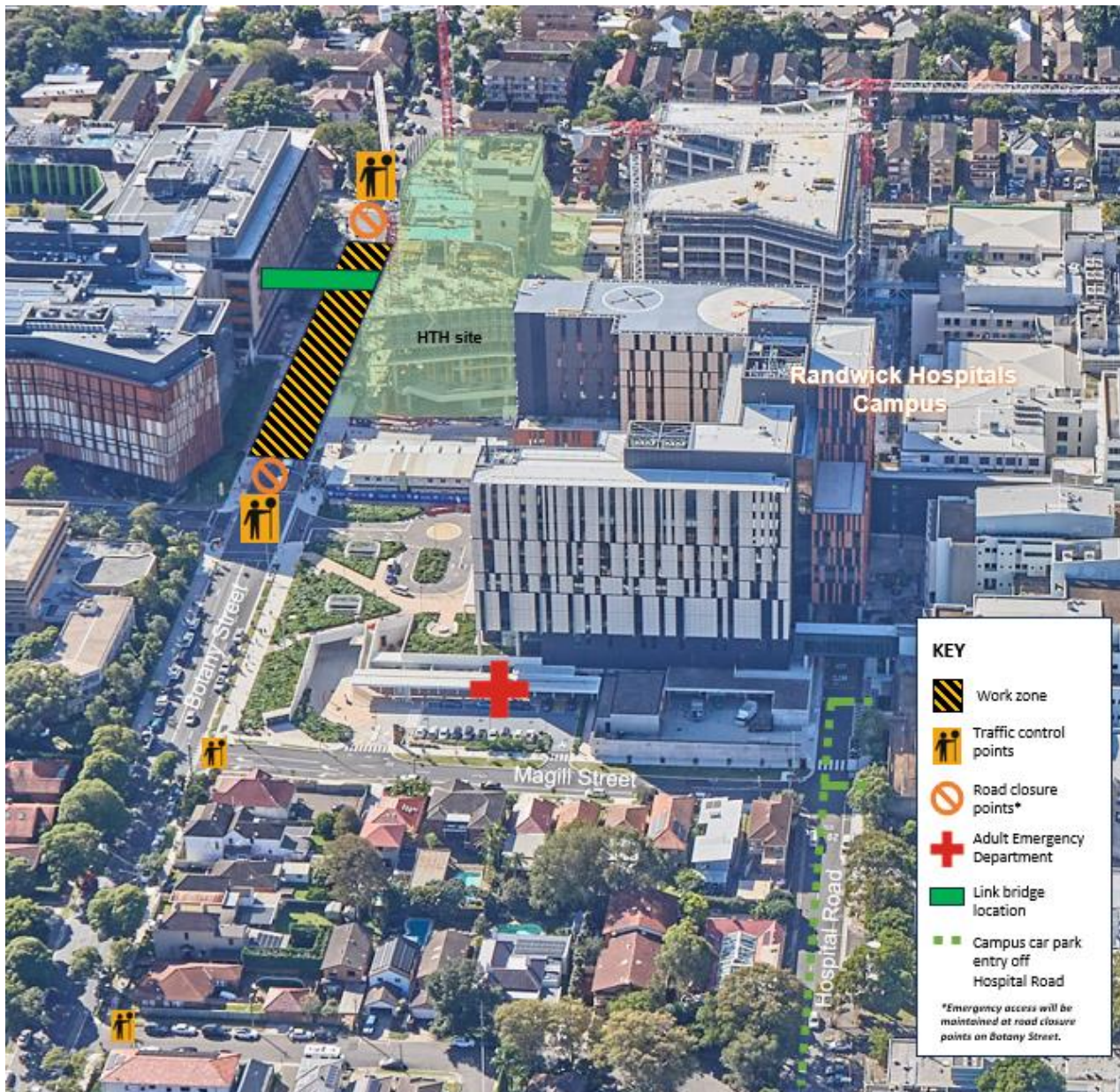
HTH principal builder Hansen Yuncken will undertake after hours and weekend works to lift the future pedestrian bridge into place from the evening of Friday 14 June to the morning of Monday 17 June inclusive.

**Bridge installation via mobile crane will occur between 8pm Friday 14 June and 5am Saturday 15 June. During the bridge lift, a section of Botany Street will temporary close between High Street and UNSW Gate 11 (Library Walk) – refer map over page. Vehicle and pedestrian detours will be in place during this time, with emergency access along Botany Street maintained.**

Between 5am Saturday 15 June and 5am Monday 17 June, related works to complete the bridge installation will continue. Botany Street access between High Street and Library Walk will be restricted to emergency vehicles, emergency department access, public transport and residents for the duration of these works. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to support vehicle detours, emergency traffic flow and pedestrian safety.

### Key impacts during these works

- Access to the Prince of Wales Hospital Adult Emergency Department (Magill Street) and Sydney Children's Hospital Emergency Department (High Street) will be maintained for the duration of the works.
- Access to the Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building entrance (Botany Street) for Non-Emergency Patient Transport (NEPT) will be maintained.
- Access to the section of Botany Street between High Street and UNSW Gate 11 will be restricted to Emergency Department access, public transport and resident vehicles only.
- The Botany Street eastern and western footpath between High Street and UNSW Gate 11 will be closed during the bridge lift on Friday night, reopening once the bridge is secure. For safety, pedestrian diversions to either footpath will be in place throughout the works.
- Access to Randwick Hospitals Campus B2 and B3 car park entry/exit driveways will be available via Hospital Road off Barker Street. Users are encouraged to avoid the Magill Street approach to avoid potential delays.
- Some noise is expected as a result of construction vehicle movements and equipment use.
