

Notification of night works – removal of gantry hoarding

Following construction completion of the Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building and UNSW Eastern Extension, works to remove the final section of protective gantry hoarding on Hospital Road and Delivery Drive will occur during late May and early June 2023.

To enable the removal of the hoarding, scaffolding will be removed on **Saturday 20 May between 8am and 5pm**, weather permitting. These works will be undertaken with the support of traffic control, however access to hospital loading docks and car park entrances will be maintained.

Out of hours activities to remove the remaining hoarding will commence on weeknights from Tuesday 23 May for approximately two weeks, weather permitting.

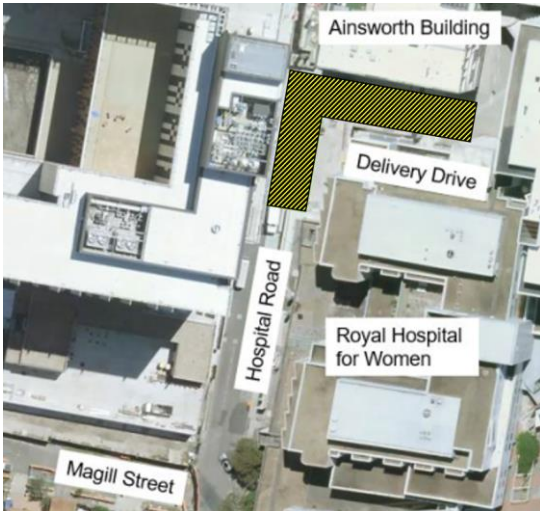
Weeknight works are approved to occur up to four nights per week within the hours of **6pm and 4am**, with any two consecutive nights of work followed by a respite night.

Activity will include vehicle and plant movements, removal of structural steel beams and columns, lifting of gantry hoardings and unfastening of steel bolts to remove the hoarding from the supporting structure.

Intermittent construction noise may be heard throughout each shift, in particular relating to the unfastening of steel bolts. Loading dock closures will be in place during these works.

Careful consideration has been placed on the planning of the hoarding removal to minimise noise and construction impacts, including scheduling and timing of the works.
