



Acute Services Building construction site activity – tower crane removal

The final tower crane associated with construction of the new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building is scheduled to be removed in December.

Due to the complex nature of the dismantle, the removal works will take place on Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 December between 7am and 5pm each day.

Works will involve the establishment of a mobile crane on site to assist in removing the tower crane in pieces, which will then be loaded onto trucks to be taken off site via the Botany Street construction gate.

Impacts will be monitored across the weekend to appropriately manage construction noise resulting from this work.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.
