

Notification of weekend works and road closure – second tower crane installation, Saturday 2 and Sunday 3 September 2023

To support ongoing construction of the new UNSW Health Translation Hub, weekend site activities to install a second tower crane will be undertaken by UNSW's construction partner, Hansen Yuncken.

Approved installation activities will occur between the hours of 1.30am and 6.30pm on Saturday 2 September, continuing between 6am and 6.30pm on Sunday 3 September.

To enable this activity, a section of Botany Street will be temporarily closed from 1.30am Saturday until completion of related activities on Sunday evening. Traffic controllers and signage will support vehicle detours.

During the road closure, access to Botany Street between High Street and Barker Street will be restricted to residents, emergency vehicles and hospital patients only, maintaining access to residential properties, Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building and the Adult Emergency Department.

From 7am and 12.30pm on Saturday 2 September, single lane southbound access will be provided between High Street and the UNSW Gate 11/Library Walk intersection to support participant access to the UNSW Open Day scheduled for this day. Similarly, UNSW campus access will be available from the south via Botany Street and Gate 11. Exit from the university campus via Gate 11 will be provided southbound only.

At all other times during the installation activity, there will be restricted through traffic access in either direction between High Street and Magill Street. Traffic controllers and signage will support vehicle detours.

There will be no access impacts to Sydney Children's Hospital Main Entrance and Emergency Department from High Street. Detours will in place via Avoca Street for those travelling from the south.

Pedestrian access along Botany Street adjacent to the worksite will be restricted to the western footpath throughout the installation works.

Some noise is likely as a result of these works. Thank you for your patience while we work to deliver this exciting project.

All activity dates and times are subject to change. Contingency dates of Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 September have been identified in case of inclement weather.
